

GENERAL INFORMATION

Foli-Zyme GA is formulated as a soluble concentrate that requires a minimum 1 to 10 dilution with water for all applications.

Foli-Zyme GA is a fluid nutrient compound designed to prevent nutrient deficiencies in plants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Recommended use:

Foli-Zyme GA may be used on the following crops at recommended rates and application intervals below: alfalfa, almonds, apples, artichokes, asparagus, avocados, barley, all beans, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, celery, citrus, corn, cotton, grapes, hops, lettuce, melons, milo, nectarines, peaches, peanuts, peas, pecans, peppers, pistachios, potatoes, rice, soybean, sorghum, strawberries, sugar beets, sugar cane, sunflowers, sweet corn, tobacco, tomatoes, turnips, walnuts, watermelons, wheat and most other crops.

Field row crops and vegetables: Foliar spray **Foli-Zyme GA** on the following schedule: Apply 1 gallon per acre (9 liters per hectare). Start applications when the crop has 2 to 3 leaves or is 20 days old. Continue sprays at 10 to 14 day intervals up to 6 times annually.

Tree, fruits and nuts: Apply 1 gallon per acre (9 liters per hectare) up to 6 times annually, beginning with delayed dormant spray.

Utilize foliar application interval of 14 days. AVOID PERIODS WHEN FRUIT IS EXTREMELY SENSITIVE

TO SPRAY DAMAGE, PRIMARILY DURING THE POLLINATION PERIOD.

Citrus: Apply 1 gallon per acre (9 liters per hectare) every 30 days. Do not mix with petroleum spray oils or ammoniated copper compounds.

Solid-seeded field crops: Apply 1 gallon per acre (9 liters per hectare) when the crop is 3 inches high. Continue foliar application on 14-day interval until crop in 14 days from harvest.

Mixing Instructions:

Many pesticides can tank mixed with **Foli-Zyme GA**. Follow this mixing procedure: 1. Water, 2. **Foli-Zyme GA**, 3. Pesticide

Foli-Zyme GA will disperse in water with little agitation.

CAUTION: Be sure to conduct a "Jar Test" using all products in proper proportion in order to establish physical compatibility.

Foli-Zyme GA has a pH range of 2.0 to 3.5 and will buffer spray tank water. The use of additional buffering agents may result in crop damage.

WARNING: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. May cause irritation of nose, throat, and/or skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing.

IF SWALLOWED: Induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Wash eyes with plenty of clear water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
