

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Bio-Hold is formulated to aid in management of abiotic stress throughout the entire growing season. Bio-Hold will provide plant nutrition to promote season long vigorous plant growth and production.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It may be a violation of law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

## RECOMMENDED USES

### FOR SEED TREATMENT, IN FURROW and TRANSPLANT APPLICATION:

Apply as a seed treatment at 2-4 ounces per 100 pounds of seed.

Apply in furrow at 4 to 8 ounces per acre. Apply to transplants in the transplant water at a concentration of 8 ounces per 100 gallons of water or foliar within 7 days after transplanting at 8-16 ounces per acre. Applications above may be utilized on any crop listed on this label specific to a given crops management practices.

### FOR FOLIAR and FERTIGATION APPLICATION:

\*Application prior to anticipated abiotic stress event are highly recommended.

\*Applications after abiotic stress event are highly recommended to aide in limiting negative effects of the event.

\*Low rate multiple applications may be used as an abiotic stress management approach to limiting season long negative impacts of abiotic stress throughout the growing season.

**Field Crops:** Alfalfa, bean crops, canola, clover, corn, cotton, forage grasses, peanut, potato, rape (canola), rice, sorghum, soy-bean, sugar beet, sugarcane, sunflower, tobacco, and wheat/barley/oat. Apply 8-16 ounces per acre every 14 to 21 days. Recommend using a minimum of two applications during the growing season; first during early vegetative growth stages and second during early grain/fruit development growth stages.

**Vegetable Crops:** Artichoke, asparagus, beet, carrot, cruciferous, fennel, herbs, leafy vegetables, melon, onion/garlic, cucurbits, eggplant, pepper, strawberry, sweet potato and tomato. Apply 8-16 ounces per acre every 7 to 21 days. Recommend applications made at planting, during early vegetative growth stages, and just prior to the beginning of flowering. Recommend application of 16 oz/a to potato crop at early to mid-bloom.

**Fruit and Nut Crops:** Almond, apple, apricot, avocado, berry crops, cherry, citrus, date palm, fig, filbert, grapes, hazelnut, hops, nectarines, oil palm, olive, persimmon, peach, pear, pecan, pistachio, plums/prune, pomegranate, subtropical fruit and walnut. Apply 8-16 ounces per acre every 7 to 21 days until 10% bloom and resume applications after petals fall. Highly recommended to apply prior to abiotic stress event, such as prior to anticipated high heat event, to limit negative impact on yield and fruit quality from such event.

**Field Grown Nursery Stock:** Cane berries, strawberry, tree and vine crops and other grafted, clonal or vegetative propagated stock plants. Apply 8-16 ounces per acre every 7 to 21 days.

**MIXING INSTRUCTION:** Follow this mixing order: (1) Water (2) Bio-Hold (3) Pesticide. Bio-Hold will disperse in water with little agitation. Bio-Hold is compatible with most fertilizers and pesticides. Always conduct a jar test when using new or untried combinations.
