---

**FOLIMINS** contains available forms of the essential plant nutrients nitrogen, potassium and calcium. Apply **FOLIMINS** to the crop foliage for immediate uptake by the plant. Use **FOLIMINS** in addition to traditional fertility programs to prevent and treat nutrient deficiencies in plants.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

---

Apply the recommended amount in a minimum of 10 gallons of solution per acre through equipment that is capable of providing uniform coverage of the leaves.

## RECOMMENDED USES

---

**FOR FOLIAR APPLICATION:** Apply to the crop foliage at 0.5 gallon per acre starting at transplant or once seeded crops have 2 to 4 true leaves, once plants are established continue at 1 gallon per acre every 7 to 21 days until 2 weeks before harvest. On perennial crops apply to the crop foliage at 1 gallon per acre just prior to bud swell and continue every 7 to 21 days until 2 weeks before harvest.

**TRANSPLANTS:** Apply **FOLIMINS** as a root dip or drench at 4 to 16 ounces per 100 gallons of water immediately before or after planting.

Use **FOLIMINS** at the recommended rate on the following crops:

**FIELD CROPS:** Alfalfa, bean crops, canola, clover, corn, cotton, forage grasses, peanut, rape (canola), rice, sorghum, soybean, sugar beet, sugarcane, sunflower, tobacco, and wheat, barley, oat, or other cereal grain.

**VEGETABLE CROPS:** Artichoke, asparagus, broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, kale, and other cruciferous vegetables, leaf lettuce, head lettuce, dandelion, radicchio, and other leafy vegetables; cucumber, melon, pumpkin, squash, and other cucurbits; onion, garlic, and other bulb vegetables; tomato, pepper, eggplant and other fruiting vegetables; strawberry; carrot, potato, sweet potato, radish, beet and other root and tuber vegetables.

**FRUIT AND NUT CROPS:** Apple, avocado, blueberry and other bush berries; blackberry, raspberry and other cane berries; sweet orange, lemon, mandarin and other citrus; date palm, fig, grapes, hops, oil palm, olive, persimmon, cherry, peach, plums, prune, nectarine, apricot and other stone fruit; almond, pecan, pistachio, walnut and other tree nuts; pear, pomegranate, and subtropical fruit.
